Arabesque is the UK contribution to the JGOFS Arabian Sea Process Study. It was a study of upper ocean microbial biogeochemistry in the Arabian Sea. Its focus was carbon and nitrogen cycling processes linked to climate change. Arabesque was supported by a field programme consisting of two cruises of RRS Discovery. Data management support was provided by BODC and over 90% of the data collected during the field programme are assembled on this CD-ROM
